1. You must meet income guidelines.

 You must be 60 years of age or older or an adult, 18-59 years old with a disability

TO QUALIFY, APPLICANTS:

- Must meet income guidelines (chart shown on reverse side)
- Must be 60 years of age or older or an adult 18-59 years receiving a disability payment
- Must live in the house to be treated

IF YOU QUALIFY, HERE'S WHAT TO DO:

- 1. Complete the application.
- Verify ALL household income using any of the following that apply:
 This program targets low income seniors and adults with a disability based on gross total household income. Therefore, participants must verify current yearly household income.
- Social Security Statement call 1.800.772.1213 to request proof
- If currently employed, two (2) current paycheck stubs
- If unemployed, copy of unemployment benefits
- Other forms of income
- 3. Submit application with supporting documentation to Cuyahoga County Division of Senior and Adult Services, 13815 Kinsman Road, Cleveland, OH 44120 or fax application to 216.420.6735. Please call us at 216.420.6700, Centralized Intake, if you need assistance in completing the application.
- 4. An inspection will be scheduled to determine the presence of bed bugs and the exter mination services required.
- 5. Preparation of the home for extermination services is required.
- 6. The County has final approval for the type and number of treatments to be provided.
